"One day, Guillaume received an e-mail from a little girl who shares a common point with him: They have both the same disease. But what she did not know is that he also practises the Padovan method. Honorine has a lissencéphalie. Her parents, helped by her godfather and godmother, launched an association to cope with the lack of centers for disabled children as young as Honorine.

No kidding! It reminds me of something. They also made the choise to complete her care system (which is actually not that bad) by regular Padovan stimulating exercises (much more regular than Guillaume does!) thanks to the involvement of volunteers who come at home to help her practicing.

HONORINE PROGRESS

Honorine is 3 years old. She has been doing stimulation exercises since the age of 1. Here are some of her new victories upon the disease that we have noticed for the last six months:

- Vision and prehension: Honorine grasps her glass on the table and takes it to her mouth to drink. She seizes an object (a spoon for instance) with a single hand thanks to an effort of concentration. The small accidents "on the way" from hand to mouth are very quickly forgiven.
- Motricity and balance: Honorine stands in sitted position and keep straight. She makes gladly some steps with support by folding the knees, with a lot of application, to do a movement which is for us so natural;
- Chewing: Honorine learns how to use her teeth to chew the small pieces that we now give her. To be perfected as the small tongue does not play the expected role!





At the beginning of the summer ", we were invited in Brussels in the office of Pepsico Belgique. We met there the marathon runners we had already met a few months earlier. Little by little, employees came to join us in the room which could not contain any more people! After an introducing speech by the Manager, we watched, with a lot of emotion, a small movie which tells about this tremendous sport and human competition. Pepsico Belgique decided to double the gifts recorded for the benefit of the association. This moment is definitely the best of our association short history and doubtless not the last ...
